Early in my career, I was tasked with designing the external interface security, firewalls, and core infrastructure for Charles Schwab's very first web-trading product. When we launched, user influx exceeded our design specifications by 40 times, but the infrastructure scaled properly and the core trading product was never compromised. I have spent decades since leading global software engineering teams for Cisco, Juniper Networks, and Sun Microsystems, and operating secure data centers.

I applied those exact same enterprise security principles to **My Last Words**. We don't just protect your data; we isolate it. Here is exactly how your vault is secured.

1. Non-Routable Storage Environments

Most standard websites store uploaded images and PDFs in a "public" directory. If someone guesses the web address, they can see the file.

My Last Words does not do this. When you upload a document, video, or image to your secure vault, it is routed to an isolated and replicated storage cluster. This environment has no direct connection to the public internet. It is physically impossible for a web browser to "stumble upon," scrape, or directly link to your sensitive files.

2. Zero-Trust Delivery Gates

Because your files are locked in an isolated environment, the only way they can be retrieved is if our core application acts as a heavily guarded courier.

When a file is requested, the application executes a strict Zero-Trust validation loop:

- Is the person requesting this the verified Owner?
- Has the Owner officially passed away (triggering the unlocking phase)?
- Does the person requesting this have a cryptographically verified Delegate PIN?
- Did the Owner assign this specific file to a compartment that this specific Delegate is authorized to view?

If even one of these checks fails, the application instantly terminates the connection. The file never moves.

3. Data Obfuscation & Anti-Enumeration

We strip the original names and easily identifiable metadata from your files the moment they touch our servers. If you upload a file named `My_Final_Will_2026.pdf`, the system instantly renames it to a randomized, long cryptographic string instead. This prevents malicious actors from executing "enumeration attacks"—systematically guessing file names to expose data.

4. Zero-Residue Deletion

When you choose to delete a file or close your vault, we don't just hide the data from your view—we execute a hard purge. The asset is permanently destroyed from the database, and the binary file is immediately wiped from the secure disk. There is no residue, no shadow copies, and no recovering it. Your data belongs to you; when you say it's gone, it's gone.

5. The Dead Man's Switch Protocol

Your private compartments (Family and Documents) are entirely inaccessible to anyone but you while you are alive. Not even your assigned Delegates can view these files. The system operates on a strict "Dead Man's Switch" protocol. The logical locks on those specific drawers are only released when the ultimate condition is met and verified, ensuring your privacy is absolute until the exact moment your family needs your guidance.
